1. God is R\_\_\_\_\_ v.3b *the Lord is God*
2. God is C\_\_\_\_\_ v.3c *It is He who made us*
3. God is O\_\_\_\_\_ v.3d *...we are His; we are His people*
4. God is P\_\_\_\_\_ v.3e *...the sheep of His pasture*
5. God is G\_\_\_\_\_ v.5a *For the Lord is good...*
6. God is L\_\_\_\_\_ v.5b *and His love endures*
7. God is F\_\_\_\_\_ v.5c *...His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations.*
