For seven weeks we have been going through The Lord's Prayer noting that each phrase is an answer to a basic life problem. If you were to take all the problems you have ever had, or ever will have, you can categorize every single problem in one of seven categories. The Lord's Prayer provides an antidote, an answer. God is saying to us, "I can, want to and will meet every need you'll ever face . . . if you will trust Me.

1. My inferiority: His p\_\_\_\_\_   
 Our Father in heaven, hallowed by Your name
2. My confusion: His p\_\_\_\_\_   
 Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven
3. My worry: His p\_\_\_\_\_   
 Give us this day our daily bread
4. My guilt: His p\_\_\_\_\_   
 Forgive us our debts
5. My strained relationships: His p\_\_\_\_\_   
 as we forgive our debtors
6. My temptations: His p\_\_\_\_\_   
 And lead us not into temptation
7. My fear: His p\_\_\_\_\_   
 but deliver us from evil

I can't say HALLOWED BY YOUR NAME unless Christ has first priority in my own life
